

Pack 7 Code of Conduct

I, _____, **promise to follow the Scout Law and the rules established by my Pack at all Den Meetings, Pack Meetings, and any Cub Scout related outings.**

These rules will include, but not be limited to, the following:

- Cub Scouts will be respectful of themselves, each other, and their Den Leaders.
- Cub Scouts will be respectful of property.
- Cub Scouts will only use kind words when speaking to each other or to adult leaders. Indoor voices will be used while indoors.
- There will be no pushing or hitting.
- There will be no running within the church or other buildings unless expressly permitted by adult leaders.
- Parents are to work cooperatively with Den and Pack Leaders to create a fun and positive environment.

Discipline at Den meetings will be at the discretion of the Den Leader in accordance with the following guidelines:

1. Failure to obey a rule will result in a warning, followed by a time out or removal from an activity. In cases of harmful or repetitive misbehavior, parents may be called to pick up their Cub Scout.
2. At the Den Leader's discretion, parents may be required to attend Den functions with their Cub Scout.
3. Den Leaders have the right to exclude a Cub Scout from a Den meeting for reasons of conduct. In cases of repetitive misconduct, the situation will be reviewed by the Pack Committee. In extreme cases, and after consultation with the Council, a Cub Scout may be dismissed from the Pack for misconduct.
