

**As always, Scouts travel in their Class A uniform. This represents them as a group and affords them a certain amount of respect when in public. Also, this will guarantee they will have their Class A uniforms at camp.**

## Clothes

- 5 pairs of socks and underwear
- A couple pairs of shorts with pockets. Please do not pack all athletic shorts. Scouts may need to carry multiple items. For this reason we recommend shorts with multiple pockets.
- A couple pairs of long pants. Preferably Scout Pants. Jeans would be ok.
- Class A Shirt for flags, meals, and camp wide activities
- Class B Shirts
- A sweatshirt
- Swimming trunks
- Hat or cap
- Rain gear

## Sleeping

- Sleeping bag (light weight)
- Pillow (optional)
- Cap for cold nights
- Sleeping clothes for cold nights (optional)
- **Mosquito Netting and poles (Very Important)**

## Footwear

- Hiking boots or Gym Shoes
- Shower Shoes for Flip-Flops

## Personal and Miscellaneous items

- Personal first aid kit. This need not be much more than a few band aids, a couple of 2x2 gauze pads, some cloth tape, a small triple antibiotic ointment like Neosporin, and maybe a small hand sanitizer.
- Mess kit. This can be as simple as a shallow bowl, a cup and a spork (a spoon/fork combination). You can find them at the Scout Shop or any outdoor sporting store. Or, a mess kit can be bought that includes a plate, bowl, cup, fork, spoon and knife. I opt for the first choice for my boys and me because Scouts are responsible for washing their own mess kits and the less cleaning the more time for fun.
- Pocket knife. Please, no fixed blade knives, only folding blade pocket knives.
- Flashlight AND extra batteries.
- Compass

- Mesh Bag. Small mesh bags come with most mess kits or if you are making up your own kit you can buy a dunk bag at the Scout shop. This allows the Scouts to hang their mess kit to dry rather than wipe it dry with a towel that may get pretty dirty by the end of a campout. We want to avoid any sick Scouts.
- Bug repellent (2 Cans of Deep Woods)
- “Afterbite” medication
- Sunscreen
- Towels
  - Hand
  - Washcloth
  - Beach
- Water bottle (refillable)
- Deodorant.
- Fishing equipment (optional)
- Scout book, pen/pencil and pad of paper.
- Camp chair ( Important )
- Cards / Uno
- Rope to make clothes line
- Money for spending at camp and Culvers
