

## Financial Aid and Assistance Opportunities for Quivira Council Scouts:

Note – QC highly encourages using the electronic application system for all recruitments and submittal of applications.

KanCare: Families that are Members of a KanCare Specific Insurance Plan (Sunflower, Aetna, United Healthcare) are eligible for a \$50 credit towards their Scouting Registration.

- This can be applied to registration once per eligible youth per year.
- Electronic - This will be filled out through a blackpug registry. A walkthrough and a QR code that will bring the user to the blackpug page will be available on the membership resources page. Upon completion, this registry sends a coupon code to the user's email for a \$50 discount when applying on beascout.org (online application).
- Paper - These can be found on the Quivira Council Membership Resources page. These can be collected alongside a paper youth application. When turned in with a paper application these are worth \$50 credit towards the yearly registration fee.

General Financial Aid: This is for families who need some financial help making it possible for their child(ren) to enjoy the Scouting Adventure.

Financial Aid Form

- Electronic – This will be filled out through a blackpug registry. A walkthrough and a QR code that will bring the user to the blackpug page will be available on the membership resources page. Upon completion, this registry sends a coupon code to the user's email for a \$35 discount when applying on beascout.org (online application).
- Paper – These can be found on the Quivira Council Membership Resources page. These can be collected alongside a paper youth application. This is set at a default amount of \$35. For any family requesting more than that amount, please have the Unit Leader send a copy of the financial aid application to [quivira198.fa@scouting.org](mailto:quivira198.fa@scouting.org) and the QC team will have a response to them within 3 business days.

Trail to the Future: Donor Designated Funds for the Wichita Metro area. These Funds were specifically donated to help offset the cost of youth registration for families who have committed to taking on adult leadership in a Scouting Unit and need financial assistance.

Popcorn Sales: A product sale conducted through the QC Office, in the fall, that is managed at the Unit level. Units earn up to 34% on traditional popcorn sales and 30% on online sales, as well as the opportunity to earn credit towards the program fee, along with other incentives. (gift cards, reduced cost of summer camp, etc.)
